Extranía

As something to start off our cookbook, I offer something I had heard of, but never managed to make before: Spiced Wine. By the end of it, it's not very alcoholic and there's a tip on making it more so if you wish or if you are going for the 'hot tottie' effect.

Ingredients:

1 bottle of red wine*

2 bottles hard cider

1 cup honey

Mulling spices to taste (I have a large mulling ball that I use and fill it with nutmeg, cinnamon, Cloves, and allspice)

(I have tried it with both Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon, neither the expensive kind. The Cabernet had more bite in the end and the Merlot resulted in a smoother drink.)

Pour red wine, hard cider, and honey into slow cooker and turn the slow cooker on high. Add mulling ball with spices. Leave on high for 1 hour or until mixture warms periodically stirring so the honey dissolves. This recipe improves with long steeping. At this point we turn it on low with the lid on and leave over night (6-8 hours.) We have let it steep for up to 48 hours and it tasted better at the end than at the beginning. Store cold. Reheat when you wish to drink it. If you want it alcoholic, add brandy to taste, it blends well with the wine.
