Medieval Extranía

Books of Hours are highly variable; however, they have some things in common, structurally.

- 1) Liturgical calendar with saints. There are common saints, saints common to a nation, and saints of individual or very local significance.
- 2) Readings from the individual Gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John)
- 3) Common prayers (This also seems to be a point of variation.)
- 4) Hours of the Virgin (format varies), Cross, and Holy Spirit.
- 5) Seven Penitential Psalms with prayer litanies (Currently I've found little on how variable these litanies and prayers after the psalms are.)
- 6) Office for the dead
- 7) Sufferages: Various prayers asking for the intervention of the Trinity, the Virgin Mary, various Apostles, and various saints. Some sufferages are more common than others.

Some books of the hours incorporate tales of saints' lives and other things as well, but this is an overview.
